"Hierarchy Tabs"



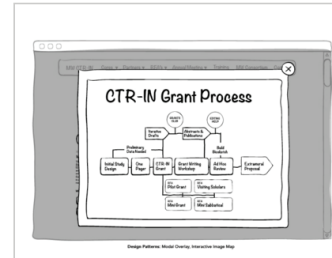
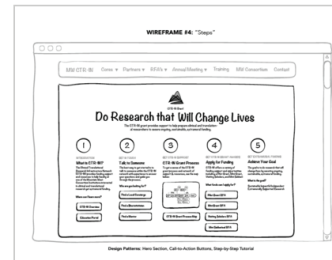

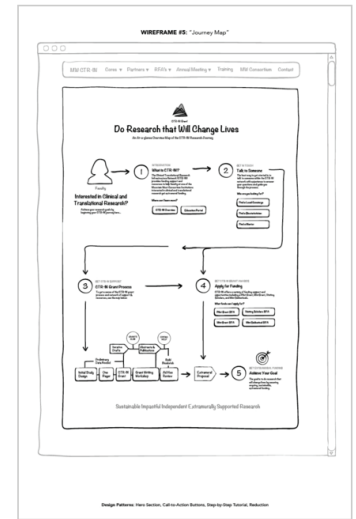

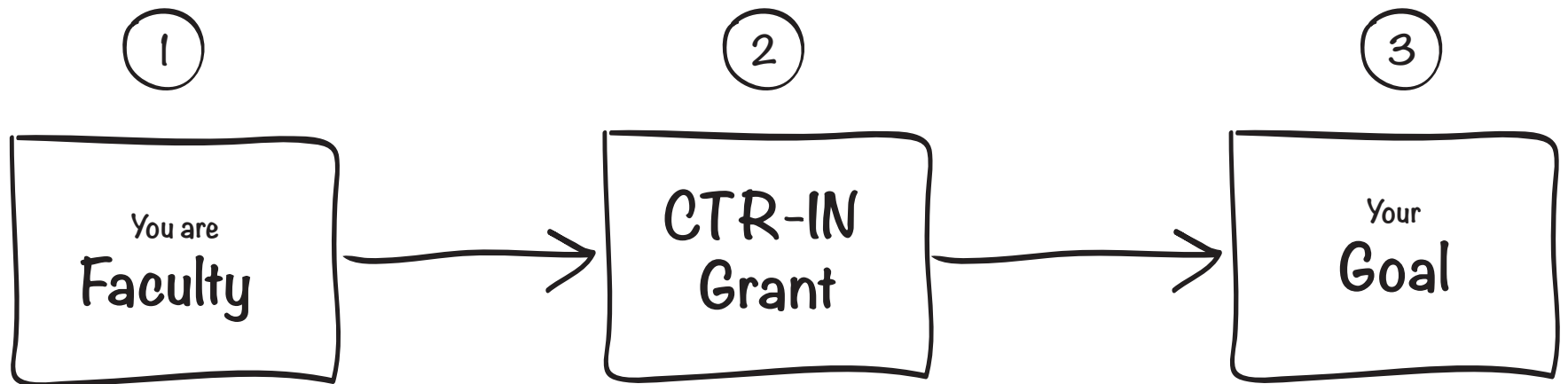

"Journey Map"



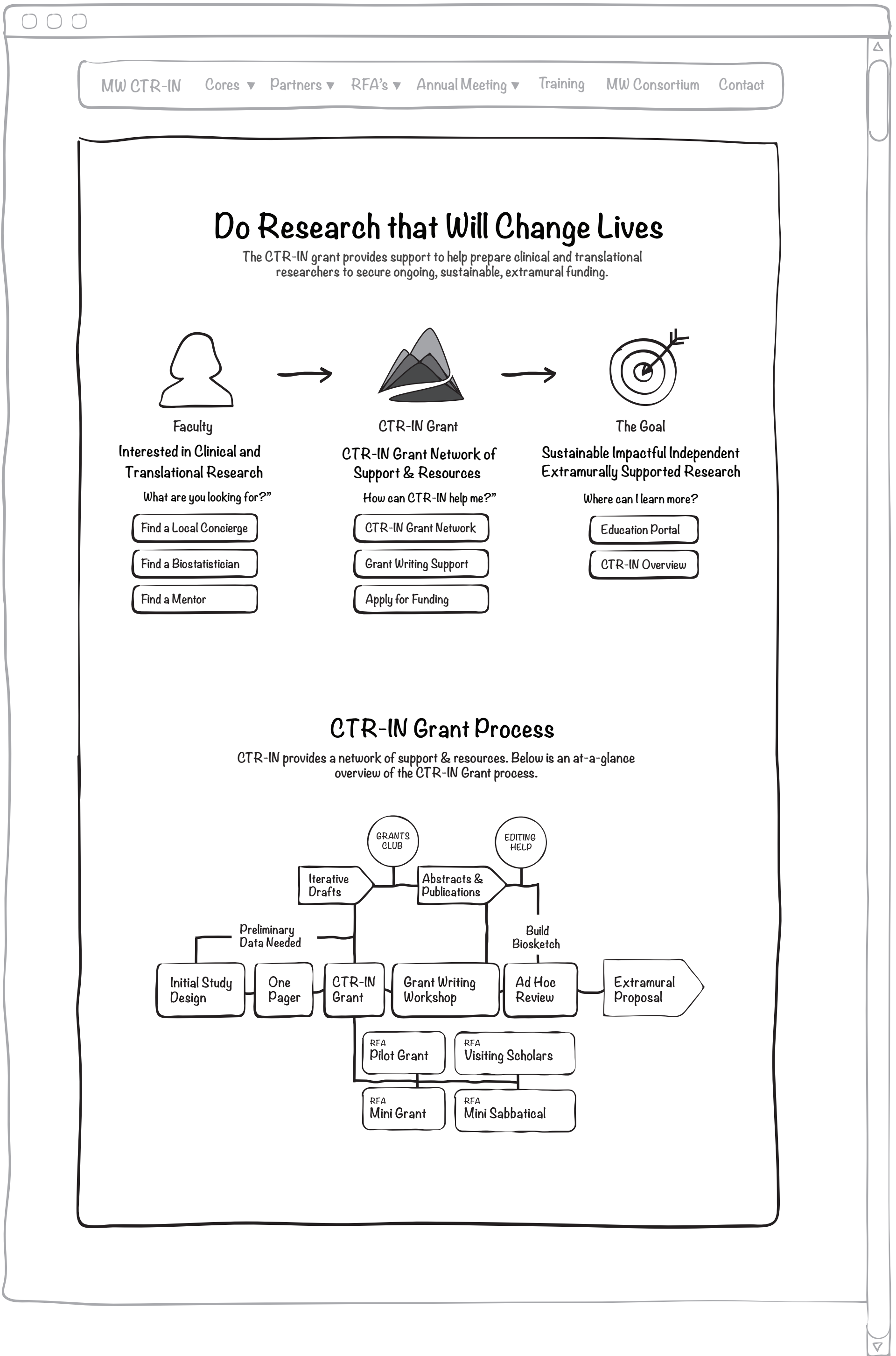

STRUCTURE MAP #1: "Linear Goal"



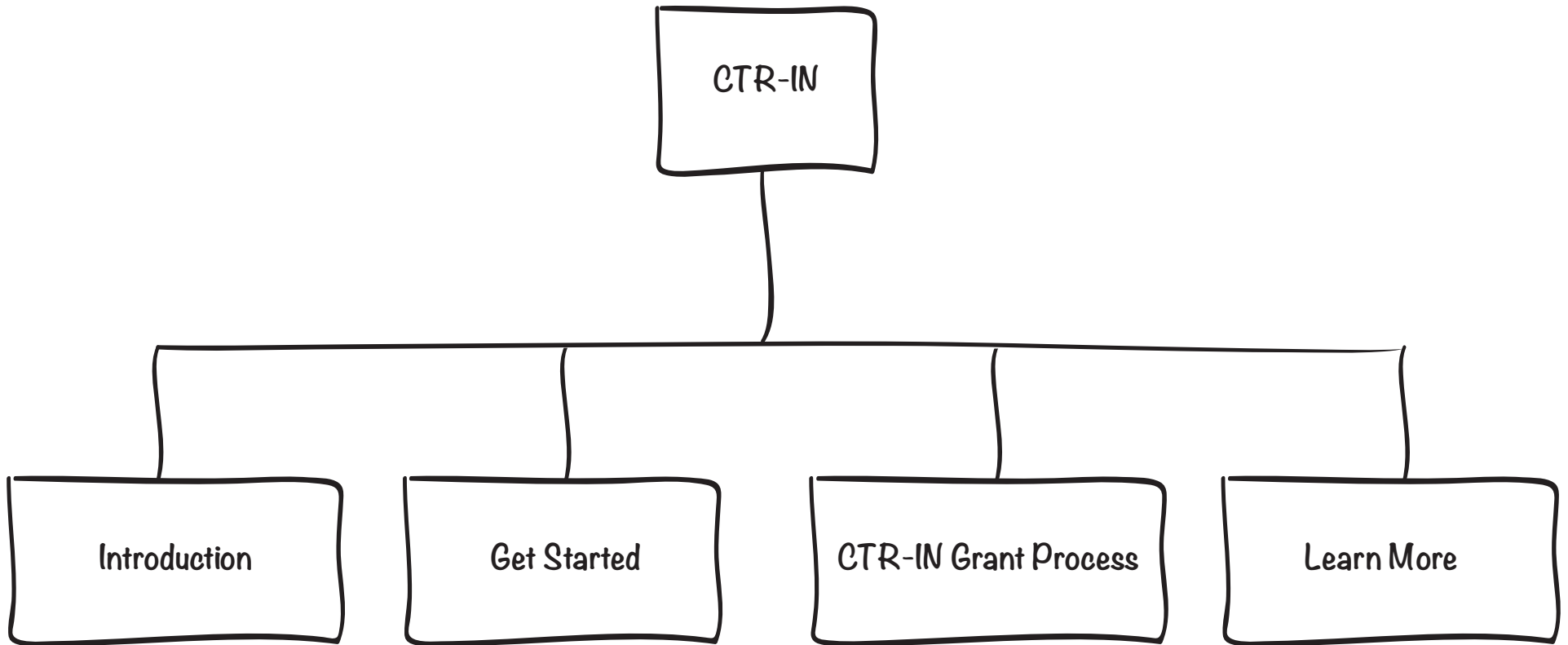
WIREFRAME #1: "Linear Goal"



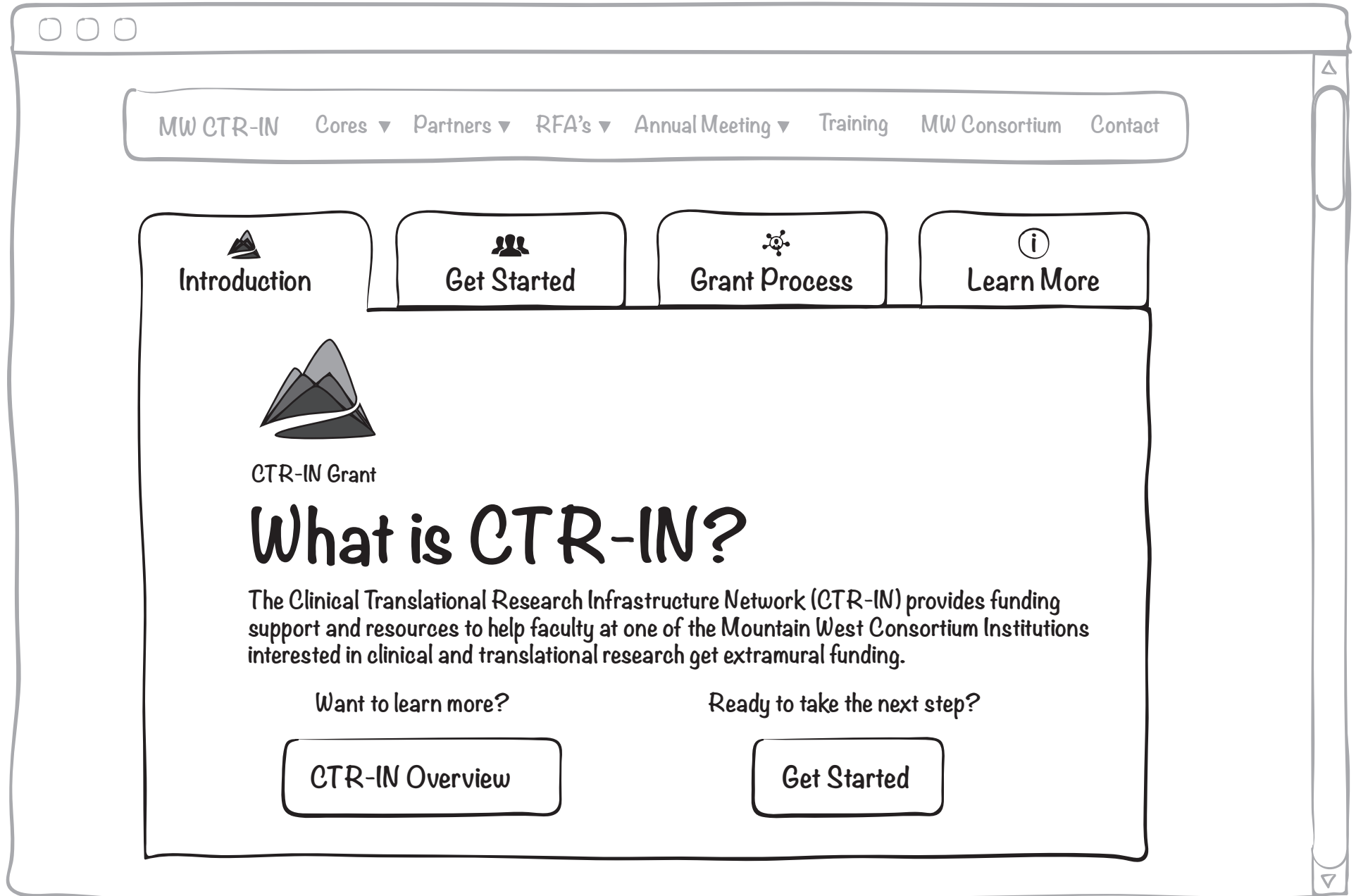

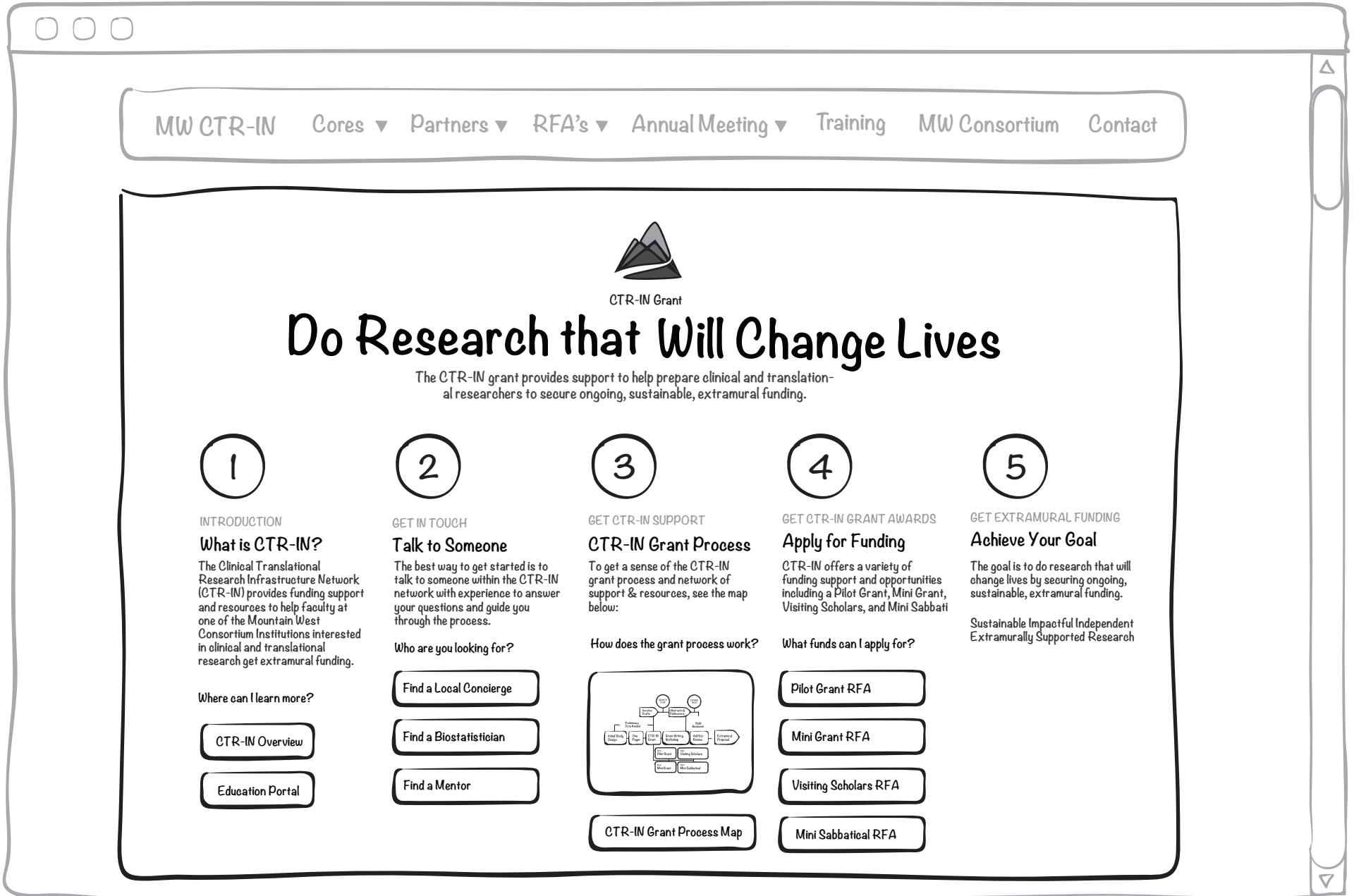

"Steps"

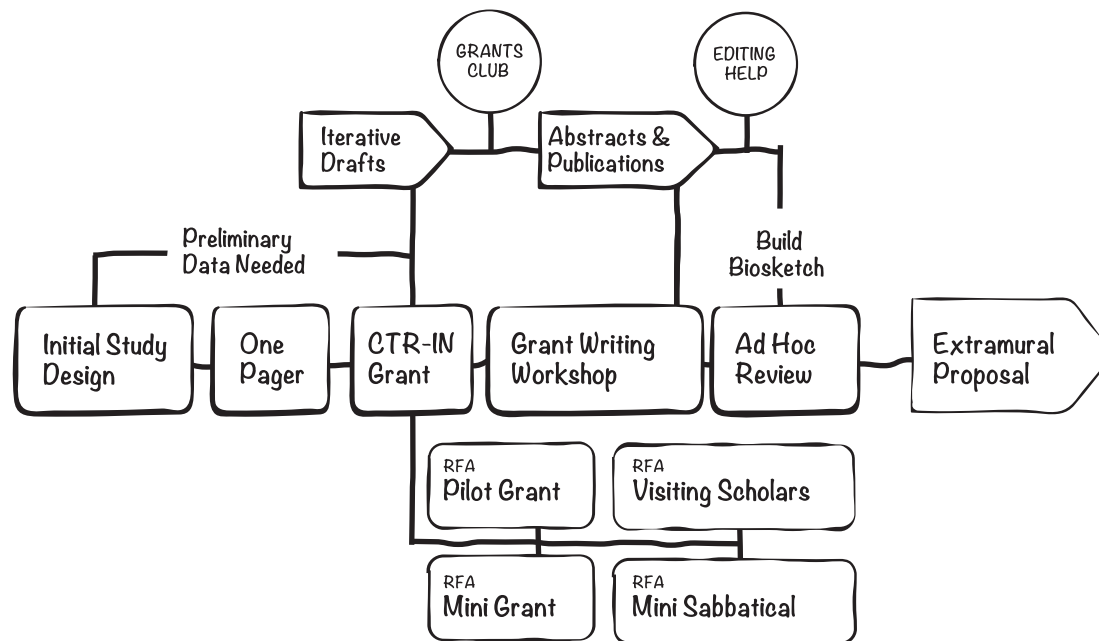
STRUCTURE MAP #4: "Steps"

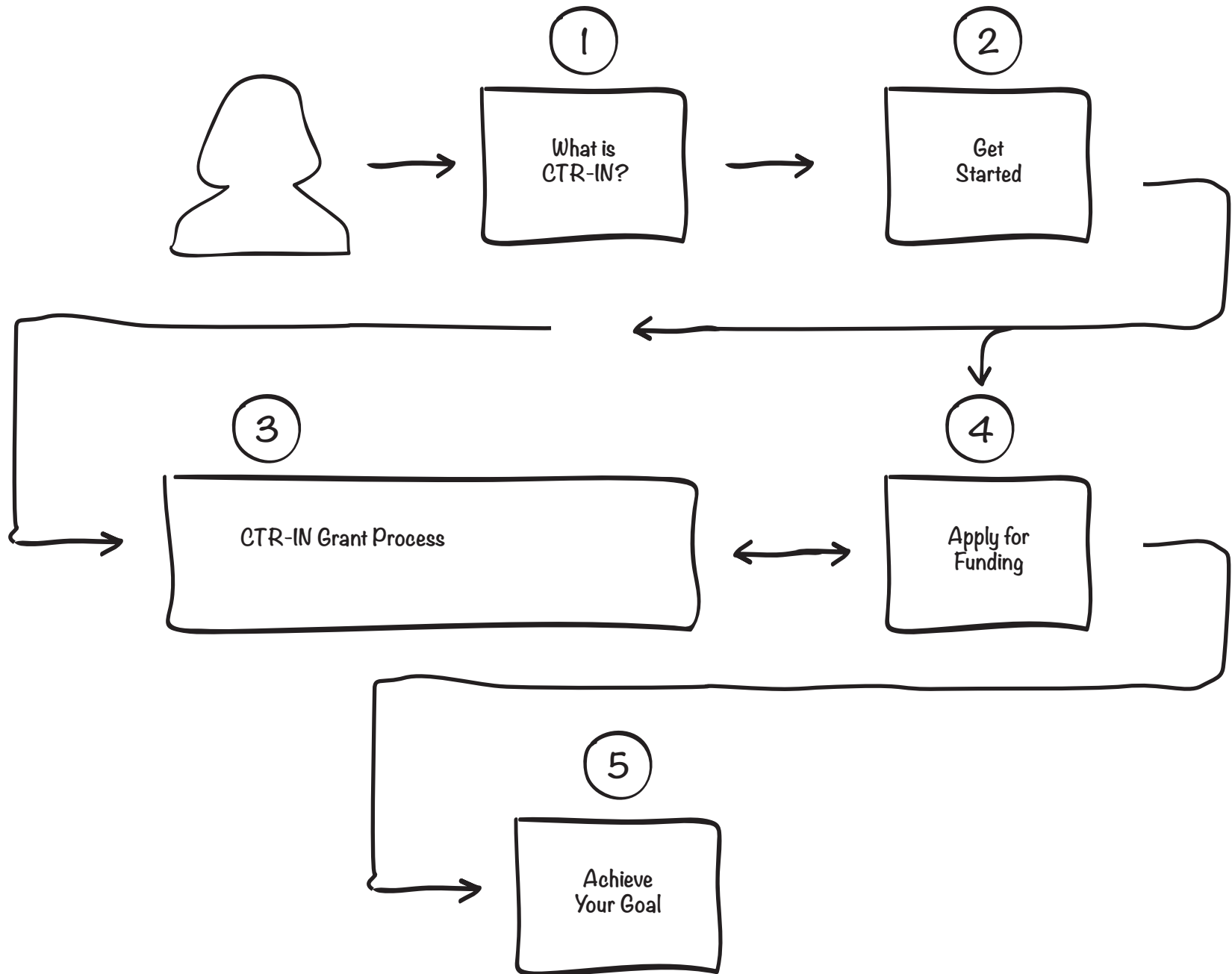
